



ADFM REPRESENTATIVE TO THE AAMC'S COUNCIL OF FACULTY AND ACADEMIC SOCIETIES

3 year term, renewable

Responsibilities

- Attend Spring CFAS meeting (*ADFM budget has funding to support this travel*)
- Attend CFAS meetings held in conjunction with the annual AAMC conference in the fall
- Prepare a written report to the ADFM Board of Directors following the Spring and Fall CFAS meetings
- Attend meetings of all family medicine CFAS representatives who attend both the Spring and Fall CFAS meetings
- Serve on the Board of Directors, including attending 3+ virtual meetings of the Board throughout the year and 3 in-person meetings – one at the end of the Annual Conference (starting in the year you are appointed), one at the start of the Annual Conference, and one in the fall, usually in conjunction with the AAMC meeting
- Attend the ADFM Business Meeting in conjunction with the Annual Conference

Length of Commitment

The length of service to ADFM is three years, renewable depending on the interest of the individual and needs of the Board of Directors.

Eligibility

- Strong familiarity with academic medical school and academic health center environments
- Chair of an ADFM member Department (usually mid-career)
- Anticipate staying in Chair role for at least 3 or more years.

The ADFM Board of Directors and Nominations Committee are interested in having a diversity of voices in the leadership of the organization.

Appointment Process

Eligible candidates are vetted by the Nominations Committee. Appointment is by Board approval.
